



## Wellness Workdays Distance Dietetic Internship Good Faith Estimate of Expenses

The WW Dietetic Intern is responsible for all housing, transportation, and personal living costs including meals while on duty and transportation costs to and from all rotations. The intern is also responsible for the cost of any approved conferences she/he chooses to attend outside of the program. Each intern assumes the responsibility to secure housing prior to starting the program and bears the cost of housing throughout the program. It is recommended that interns find housing within one-hour commute of selected rotation sites.

### Estimated Expenses and Costs\*

Each intern is responsible for the following costs and related items:

- Application fee to internship (non-refundable): \$75
- DICAS application fee: \$50/\$25
- D&D Digital application fee: \$55
- Program tuition: \$12,000
  - Non-refundable deposit of \$1,000 due within 48 hours from time of acceptance to secure spot
  - \$5,500 due by May 15<sup>th</sup>; \$5,500 due by June 15<sup>th</sup> (for Spring Match)
  - \$5,500 due by December 15<sup>th</sup>; \$5,500 due by January 15<sup>th</sup> (for Fall Match)
  
- Graduate school tuition: \$850-\$1,300+/credit hour
- Insurance (auto, medical & professional liability) \$1,200 +
- Virtual Orientation \$0
- Internship supplies (notebooks, paper, lab coat etc): \$75
- Requirements for Distance Education Component
  - Laptop \$300-\$2,000
  - Internet Service \$30-\$60/month
- Program and facility related requirements Varies \$95+
  - May include, but not limited to, costs for background checks, tuberculosis test, drug tests, and immunizations (e.g., MMR, Hepatitis B, Tetanus).
  
- Registration Exam application fee to be paid to CDR: \$200
